



Signing of MoU between French Company Prométhée Earth Intelligence and Greek Company Terra Spatium

September 15, 2023 - French Embassy in Athens - Prométhée Earth Intelligence, a French new space operator specializing in nanosatellite constellations for Earth observation, and Terra Spatium, a Greek company specializing in geospatial remote sensing and geoinformation services, have concluded a strategic cooperation agreement.

This partnership between France and Greece aims to develop bilateral cooperation in the field of high-revisit-rate Earth observation satellite systems, data generation, and advanced services for the benefit of communities and the environment. This collaboration brings significant synergies to both countries in the context of strengthening European and international sovereign space capabilities for a safer and more sustainable world.

The signing of the cooperation agreement between Prométhée Earth Intelligence and Terra Spatium is intended to enable both French and Greek innovators and technology experts to enhance their capabilities in combating the effects of climate change and improving civil protection capabilities in the face of major natural disasters, as exemplified by the forest fires and floods of the summer of 2023. These technological developments are of paramount importance for the years ahead.

This protocol aims to deploy sovereign decision support infrastructure and tools, supporting state and regional operations as well as major European projects to facilitate governance of territories by complementing existing means.

This partnership between France and Greece is central to the prevention policy and aligns with Greece's AEGIS program, recently presented by Greek authorities.

The agreement was signed by Olivier PIESPZ, CEO of Prométhée Earth Intelligence, and Evangelos VERONIKIATIS, CEO of Terra Spatium, at the residence of the French Embassy.

<u>Prométhée Earth Intelligence</u> is a French new space operator specializing in nanosatellite constellations for Earth observation, with the goal of democratizing the use of satellite imagery for a safer and more sustainable world. PROMÉTHÉE Earth Intelligence addresses crisis management and sustainable development challenges by providing strategic intelligence and environmental intelligence services. The range of applications offered by PROMÉTHÉE Earth Intelligence is virtually unlimited, including maritime surveillance, critical infrastructure protection, ecosystem





preservation, water resource management, wildlife conservation, combating deforestation, illegal fishing, and disaster prevention.

Founded in January 2020, Prométhée Earth Intelligence has received support from the French government, the Public Investment Bank (BPI), and the French National Center for Space Studies (CNES) as part of the France Relance program. As a member of the French Aerospace Industries Association (GIFAS), the company has established partnerships with over 50 French and European companies. Its first satellite, Protométhée Earth Intelligence, is set to be launched on November 1, 2023, from Vandenberg, California.

Prométhée Earth Intelligence's solutions enable both states and private clients to optimize sustainable resource management. The company has already been selected by European institutions to shape the future of the Copernicus program by providing innovative data— a system that notably supported Greece during the August 2023 wildfire crisis.

Terra Spatium SA is a Greek SME with over 30 years of experience in the fields of communications, remote sensing, software development, and complex services for geospatial research and development applications. As part of Greece's participation in the French HELIOS II satellite project, Terra Spatium has been providing on-site industrial support for the Greek satellite ground station since 2009. Terra Spatium has also established various partnerships with foreign companies, participating in projects of the European Space Agency (ESA) and the European Defense Fund (EDF) related to transportation security, coastal erosion prevention, precision agriculture, and communications for naval applications.
